- 3. Explain to the student(s) why you are nominating them for this leadership program and encourage them to apply. Applications are available outside rooms 288 and 241 and in main office.

Students must submit applications by **May 10**, so please try to give your nominees enough time to complete the application.

Finally; we would like to highlight that **this nomination does not guarantee acceptance into the program.** Additionally, nominated students will still be required to participate in reference checks and interviews just like the rest of the applicants.
