Summer School 2024-Informational Letter/Registration

Dear Student/Parent/Guardian,

Thank you for your interest in Mansfield High School's summer school program for summer 2024. In order to register your child for classes this summer, we require that you complete all the information requested below.

Please use the following form (link will be posted to the MHS website on 6/20) to register your student for summer school at Mansfield High School.

Registration will open on Thursday June 20, 2024 and remain open until the start of the second day of classes on Friday June 28th. Classes begin Thursday June 27th and will run Monday through Friday until the last day of classes on Thursday July 18th. There will be no classes held on Thursday July 4th or Friday July 5th. All classes will be held in-person at Mansfield High School. Session 1 runs from 7:30 a.m.-9:40 a.m., and Session 2 runs from 9:45 a.m.-11:55 a.m. The cost of each summer school course for in-district residents is \$275 plus a \$25 non-refundable registration fee. The cost of each summer school course for out of district students is \$300 plus a \$25 non-refundable registration fee. If you are an out of district student, you must submit an eligibility letter from your school of record (this can be turned in on the first day of classes).

We are projected to run the following courses (dependent on enrollment and staffing): Bio, Alg 1, Alg 2, Geometry, US History I/II, English 9/10, English 11/12, Spanish.

In person registration will also take place in person on June 25 and June 26 from 9:00am to 11:00 am.
